Recommendation was made to switch the switches to a motion sensor so the lights will be off for the night after the doors are locked. Need to reset the timer to

8pm for the bathrooms. Brian Morro recommended signs for the fields that remind parents that their players are just kids. An inquiry was made regarding ticks at the Civic Club and Christine will follow up to Jeff to see if the parks are sprayed for ticks.

The scoreboard at Civic Club field is not working and that needs to be looked at. Rob will call the company to follow up. Tournament teams are being worked on and Rob asked Paul to send out an email blast with the tryout schedule. Coaches should send their team tryout dates to Randy for scheduling purposes. The schedule should be sent to all players. Brian Morro reached out to Hamilton Little Lads to try to coordinate baseball games but was unable to work out anything with them to schedule some games this season.
