**Reports from Subcommittee:**

**Soccer:** Brian Morro: still working on a league meeting. Some of the reps would like to see some changes with the league. Colleen discussed the idea of soccer being run by NBIAA for the northern townships. Registration is still open. Picture Night is scheduled for September 9<sup>th</sup>. Colleen suggested looking into organizing an Opening Night celebration like we had for Baseball/Softball last year. Brian will look into this idea. Dick's Sporting Goods will have NBIAA Day in August and also donate equipment (size 3 or 4 soccer balls, 10-12 pinnies, and 10-12 cones per kit) to all our NBIAA townships. We will close the large field at MCP by the playground and Jeff will seed that field this Fall. NJ youth soccer's new rules will start to be implemented this year with the travel clubs and rec programs will not be required to change field sizes until 2017. Colleen Herbert asked about reaching out to the new students at each of the schools. Christine will contact the school to find out about in getting information out the new students and see if we can have the recreation website link added to the school website.

**Baseball:** Rob Siverio: Season went well and district teams did great. 8U played well but lost at Districts; 10U won at Districts then lost at States, 11U won Districts and currently still playing States.
