ORDINANCE 2014-8

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANSFIELD, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING ORDINANCE 2013-12 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MANSFIELD ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT" BY
ADDING A TERM FOR OFFICE FOR THE DEPUTY CLERK**

Be it enacted by the Mansfield Township Committee that the following section is hereby amended as follows:

2-2.2 DEPUTY CLERK: NJSA40A:9-135.

Assists the Municipal Clerk in the duties and functions of the office and, in the absence of the Municipal Clerk, will have all the powers of the Municipal clerk and shall perform the functions and duties of such office. The Deputy Municipal Clerk will hold office for a term of one year from January 1 of the year of his/her appointment or until such time as his/her successor has been appointed.

REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Committee hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
