Getting a flu shot is the best thing you can do to protect yourself and your loved ones from the flu this season. Clinics will be held on **Thursdays**.

Adult's Clinics are for individuals 18 years of age and older. *No children will be vaccinated.*

Children's Clinics will be held on October 5, November 9, December 7, December 28, and January 4, 2018.

There will be a **drive-thru clinic** on **Saturday October 14**.

Pneumonia vaccines are no longer offered. Contact your doctor to get a pneumonia vaccine.

Vaccinations are available free of charge to residents. Donations are appreciated at \$15 for the flu shot.
